Cycling To School Policy

April 2024

As a Health Promoting and an Active School, pupils are encouraged to walk or cycle to school.

Year Groups Permitted to cycle to school:
Years 4 - 7

Consent

A Consent Form must be completed before a pupil is able to bring their bicycle to school.

Parents accept that:

- The school has no responsibility for my child as they cycle to and from school each day
- The child's bicycle is left in school at their own risk and that the school has no responsibility for any damage/theft while it is on school premises.
- They are responsible for their child's bicycle being in a safe condition to cycle.

Ballyoran Primary School insists:

- that all pupils must wear cycling helmets for their own safety when cycling.
- that pupils must dismount the bicycle and wheel it while on school premises to ensure the Health and Safety of others.

Failure to adhere to the above rules may mean that a pupil is banned from bringing their bicycle to school.

Parking

Bicycle must be parked in the Bike Racks outside the front door.

Cycling Proficiency

All Year 7 pupils get the opportunity to complete the Cycling Proficiency Test.
