INFORMATION FOR ALL PARENTS - CONFIRMED POSITIVE COVID-19 CASE

I wish to inform you that a pupil in Nursery 2 has tested positive for Covid-19.

I have sought the most up-to-date advice from the Public Health Agency (PHA) and would like to assure you that I am following their advice at every stage.

The parents of the pupils who have been identified as close contacts have been informed. Those children must now self-isolate for 10 days from the last date of contact. Nursery 2 is now closed and will reopen on **Monday 22nd March**. Pupils in this class will move to Online Learning on See Saw for the rest of this week.

If you have not received a letter from PHA, then your child was not in close contact with the positive case and they are free to attend school as normal.

At this stage, the affected area of the school has been closed and will undergo an enhanced clean. All other areas around the school remain unaffected.

I do appreciate the concern of parents, pupils and the wider school community and wish to reassure you that every precaution has been taken.

Ensuring the safety of pupils and staff continues to be my number one priority and I will continue to monitor this situation carefully and keep you informed.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank parents for wearing face coverings and keeping a strict social distance when dropping off and picking up pupils and ask you to continue to do this.
