Online Learning

Homework

As previously communicated, homework will begin next week for Year 2 – 7 pupils. Year 1 homework will begin in October. To reduce the risk for pupils and staff, homework will be set for the entire week on Mondays and must be returned on Fridays.

Homework will be a mix of paper and our new online Google Classroom which all pupils will have access to. Guidance on accessing this at home will be sent out next week and will also be available on the school website.

If pupils or parents have any difficulty with this, paper copies of homeworks can be requested.

Year 2 homework will be Literacy and Numeracy using Google Classroom.

Year 3 – 7 homework will be as follows:

- Reading: Library book or novel
- Spellings/tables will be in your child's spelling book
- One Literacy activity will be on Google Classroom
- Numeracy activities will be assigned through Mathletics

The changes to how homework is set and completed will be kept under review.

Pupils who are off school because of Covid-19

Please note that during the current pandemic, we will provide online home learning to pupils who are unable to come to school because they fall into the following categories:

1. Pupils who are clinically vulnerable and medical guidance indicates they should refrain from school.
2. Pupils who have tested positive for coronavirus disease and are self-isolating.
3. Pupils, where a member of their household has tested positive for coronavirus disease with the result that they are required to self-isolate.
4. Pupils who are required to quarantine as a consequence of Coronavirus restrictions.

Online Home Learning will be through See Saw for Nursery and Google Classroom for Years 1 – 7.
