Collection of Second Home Learning Packs

I hope that you and your family remain safe and well. I informed you a couple of weeks ago that staff have been working on a second Home Learning Pack for pupils. These will be ready for collection in on **Monday 11th May 2020** and I would ask you to collect your pack/s as follows:

9.00 – 9.30am	Nursery
9.30 – 10.00am	Year 1
10.00 – 10.30am	Year 2
10.30 – 11.00am	Year 3
11.00 -11.30am	Year 4
11.30 – 12noon	Year 5
12.00 – 12.30pm	Year 6
12.30 – 1.00pm	Year 7 & LSC

Parents who have more than one pupil in the school, should come in for their youngest child's time slot and collect all packs during the one visit.

Please adhere to the following procedures when collecting packs which are in line with current government guidance:

- Only one person per family is permitted to enter school to collect the packs.
- Ensure a 2 metre social distance is kept between yourself and others.
- A one-way system will be in place to aid social distancing, parents should enter the school dinnerhall via the main front entrance and exit through the back entrance.
- Hand sanitiser will be available at the front door.

A reminder that an overview of the Home Learning Packs along with many other free ideas/resources/websites are available in 'Children' and 'Home Learning.'

There has been continued speculation in the media, about when schools will reopen. At this time, we do not know when this will happen, so we have prepared enough work in the Home Learning Packs for the possibility that pupils may not be back in school before the end of June. I will of course give you more information on the reopening of school when I have received this.
